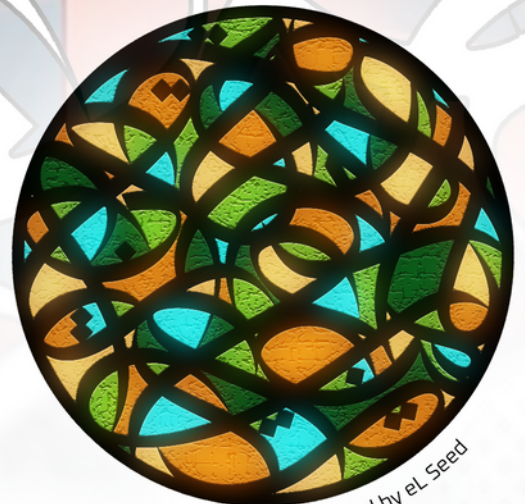

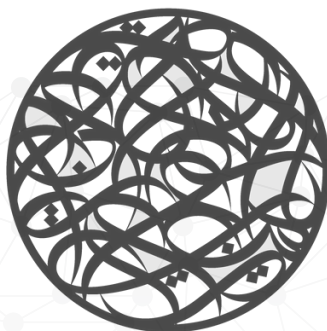

Preamble



Cybersecurity is built on technical skills and trust. By participating in Cyberoasis 1.0, each participant and team commits to respecting this charter. Any violation may lead to disciplinary actions (warning, point deduction, disqualification) and, in the case of serious offenses, referral to competent authorities.



1. Respect and Courtesy

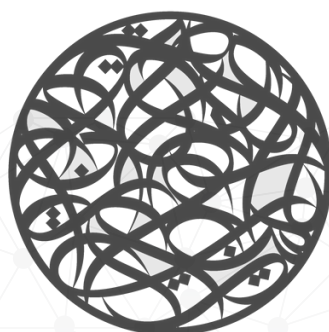


- I respect the organizers, staff, jury, and fellow participants.
- I maintain professional and courteous behavior throughout the event.

2. Scope of Action



- I will only attack machines and services explicitly provided for the CTF/Hackathon.
- I will not attempt to access external infrastructures outside the defined scope (university networks, external servers, other teams' equipment, etc.).

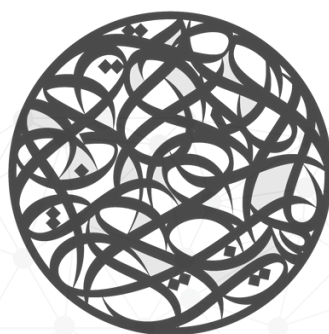


3. Fair Play and Integrity

- I will not cheat: no use of unauthorized scripts, tools, or accounts; no flag sharing between teams; no impersonation.
- I will accept the decisions of the organizers and jury regarding disputes and penalties

4. Confidentiality and Responsible Disclosure

- I will not publish solutions, flags, or vulnerabilities before the official end of the event, unless explicitly authorized by the organizers.
- If I discover a critical vulnerability outside the scope, I will report it immediately to the organizers and refrain from public disclosure.



5. Responsible Use of Knowledge

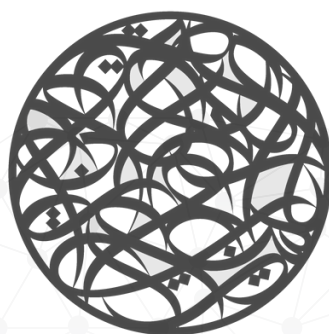


- I commit to using the skills acquired during the event legally and ethically.
- Any malicious or illegal use of techniques learned may result in prosecution and reporting to authorities.

6. Respect for Equipment

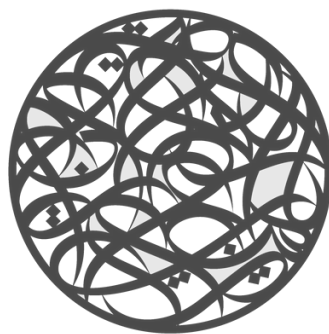


- I will handle the equipment provided with care. Any deliberate damage may result in sanctions and financial liability.



7. Sanctions and Procedures

- Warning for minor violations.
- Point deduction or removal for rule breaches. Disqualification for serious violations (attacks outside the scope, scoreboard compromise, etc.).
- In case of severe and/or illegal actions, the organizers reserve the right to file complaints and report the incident to authorities.



Sanctions: warning → score penalty → disqualification.
