

About the Event

Cyber Oasis 1.0 is a Capture the Flag (CTF) Hackathon focusing on offensive security and penetration testing. Participants from Tunisia, Algeria, and Libya will compete for 17 hours to solve real-world style hacking challenges.

Dates & Venue

Dates: November 7-9, 2025

Venue: Faculty of Science of Gabès (FSG), Gabès, Tunisia

Competition Duration: 17 hours (non-stop)





Team Structure

- Teams are composed of 2 participants (duo format).
- Each team must designate one Team Captain who will handle communication with organizers.
- Teams must bring their own laptops (BYOD). Power and internet will be provided.

What You Need to Bring

- Laptop (recommended: 8 GB RAM, 50 GB free disk, updated OS).
- Power adapter.
- Personal tools/software (Kali Linux, Burp Suite, Wireshark, etc.).
- Valid ID (student card or national ID).

- Staff on-site will help with logistics and rules clarification.

Competition Instructions

Platform

- All team creation, flag submission, and scoreboard tracking will be handled through the official platform.
- Teams receive login credentials at registration.

Flags

- A valid flag is in the format: KYBS{...}.
- Flags must be submitted via the platform only.

Issues

- If your challenge instance is unreachable, open a support ticket via the platform.
- Do not attempt to attack or reset infrastructure.

Rules of Engagement

- Attack only the targets provided.
 No DoS/DDoS attacks.
- Do not attack the scoreboard. internet, or other participants.
- No flag sharing between teams.
- Respect staff and participants.

Sanctions: warning \rightarrow score penalty \rightarrow disqualification.

Scoring System

• Easy machine: 20 pts

• Medium machine: 40 pts

• Hard machine: 70 pts

First Blood Bonuses:

- First user flag on a machine: +5 pts
- First root flag on a machine: +10 pts
- Ranking is updated live on the scoreboard. Tie-breaker: fastest solving time.

Deliverables

- Teams must submit flags through the official platform only.
- No jury presentations required.

Certificates & Prizes

- Certificates of participation for all.
- Prizes for top-ranking teams, supported by sponsors.
- Special awards may be given for fastest solves or outstanding performance.

Dispute Resolution

- Disputes can be raised through the platform.
- Organizers review and respond within 2h.
- Organizers' decision is final.
